FUN WITH ABSTRACT

During this Abstract Art visit, students will have the opportunity to create a variety of abstract pieces that may include activities such as: paper weaving, layered self portraits, patchwork silhouettes and scratch foam prints. These activities will help enhance motor and cognitive skills for young artists!



CREATIVE FORMS

Sculpting is a great way for children to use their imaginations and be inventive all while developing motor skills. This Sculptural Art experience may include hand built clay creations, cardboard sculptures or paper line sculptures.

Abstract art is the perfect way for young adults to unleash their imaginations and creativity. During the Abstract Art experience for grades 6-12, students may be guided through creating layered self portraits, paper mosaics or a colorful linework landscape.

INTEGRATING WRITING IN THE VISUAL ARTS CLASSROOM
